

## **CHAPTER 58 RELOCATION OF BUILDINGS**

### **58.01 APPLICATION AND HEARING**

Any person seeking to relocate an existing building in the Municipality shall apply to the Clerk for a hearing date for a relocation permit.

### **58.02 CONTENTS OF APPLICATION**

The applicant shall supply the following:

- (A) Legal description of the land upon which the building is to be placed.
- (B) The nature of the building to be moved, together with a picture of the building.
- (C) A certified abstract of all owners of the property located within 350 feet of the proposed relocation site and the mailing addresses of each property owner.
- (D) The payment of a \$25.00 fee.

### **58.03 HEARING**

The application together with the material requested above shall be referred to the Council who shall set a time and place for a public hearing giving at least ten days published notice of such hearing. Mailed notice shall go to all property owners within 350 ft. of the relocation site.

### **58.04 STATE BUILDING CODE**

All of the provisions of Chapters 90,91,92, and 93 will be applicable to the building to be moved and said building shall conform to the provisions of said chapters prior to moving into the City or a new site.

### **58.05 MOVING OF BUILDING**

If, under a permit from the State or County Highway Department, a building is to be moved through, but not from or to the Municipality, the requirements of this chapter shall not be imposed, but the person moving the building shall, before entering the City, notify in writing the Building Inspector of his intentions to do so, setting forth in such notice the number of the permit issued to him by the State or County Highway Department.

### **58.06 FEES**

In addition to all fees provided by this code, the applicant shall pay all expenses of inspection outside of the City including 25 cents per mile, mileage and \$7.50 per hour traveling time.
