

**CHAPTER 140**  
**REGULATIONS**  
**OF THE USE OF HIGHWAYS, STREETS AND ROADS**  
**WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY**

**140.01 HIGHWAYS, STREETS AND ROADS**

The regulatory provisions of Minnesota Statutes 1945, Chapter 168, 169, and 171 as amended from time to time, including amendments enacted by the regulatory ordinances relative to the use of highways, streets and alleys and of motor vehicles and drivers, and all other vehicles within the Municipality are hereby incorporated in and made a part of this Code as completely as if set out herein full.

**140.02 ACCELERATION**

No person shall operate a vehicle on a public highway, street, parking lot, alley or other public property or allow the motor to backfire, except when an emergency creates the necessity for such operation.

**140.03 IRREGULAR OR ERRATIC DRIVING**

No person shall drive a vehicle on a public highway, street, parking lot, alley, or other public property at irregular or erratic and changing speeds or in such a manner as to cause said motor vehicle to skip or slide upon acceleration or stopping or in a manner that simulates a temporary race, or that causes the vehicle to turn abruptly or sway, except when an emergency creates the necessity for such operation.

**140.03 PENALTY**

Any person violating the provisions of this chapter shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, unless otherwise provided by law as a petty misdemeanor.
