

CHAPTER 301
MINORS - CURFEW

301.01 MINORS 16 YEARS AND UNDER. It shall be unlawful for any minor of the age of 16 years or under to loiter, idle or be in or upon the public streets, highways, parks, playgrounds or other public grounds, public places, places of entertainment, or refreshment or any other unsupervised place within this Municipality between the hours of 10:00 P.M. on any day and 5:00 A.M. the following day unless said minor is on their way home.

301.02 DEFENSE. This chapter shall not apply to such minor accompanied by his or her parent, guardian or other adult person having the care and custody of the said minor or other adult person having the care and custody of the said minor or when the minor is upon some necessary errand by permission or direction of said parent, guardian or other adult person having the care and custody of the said minor, which permission shall be in writing and signed by such parent, guardian or other adult person having the care and custody of the said minor.

301.03 ADULTS LIABILITY. It shall be unlawful for the parent, guardian or other adult person having the care and custody of a minor to loiter, idle or be in or upon the public streets, highways, parks, playgrounds or other public grounds, public places, places of entertainment, or refreshment or any other unsupervised place within this Municipality during the hours prohibited herein.

301.04 SCHOOL NIGHTS. The Mayor of the City may designate certain nights during the school year as "School Nights". The provisions of this Chapter shall not apply to any student under the ages of 18 years or to his or her parent, guardian or other adult person having the care and custody of said minor who is lawfully going to, attending or returning from any school function on any designated "School Night".

301.05 PENALTY. Any minor of the ages set forth herein or any person having care and custody of such minor who shall violate the provisions of this chapter shall, upon conviction thereof, be guilty of a misdemeanor.
