

**CHAPTER 400  
MISDEMEANORS**

**400.01 ADOPTION BY REFERENCE.**

The acts, types and causes of behavior enumerated in this chapter constitute misdemeanors and are punishable as provided in chapter 2.11, subd. 1 of this code. The following provisions and section of Minnesota Statutes chapter 609, the criminal code of 1963, as amended, are hereby adopted by reference and made a part of this code as if fully set forth herein.
